

## Who Came First

### The Hebrew Messiah or the Greek Jesus

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Is it important to know who came first and or if they are the same person with different names? YeShua or Jesus. Or does it really matter. There are those who say it does not matter but I submit to you they are not the same, and it does matter.

The supporting text to this issue is written Hebraic-ally in Yeshayahu Isaiah 14:12 *Oh Lucifer, son of the morning, how you have fallen from the heavens! You weakening the nations, you are cut down to the ground. 13 For you have said In your heart, I will go up to the heavens; I will raise my throne above the stars of El, and I will sit in the mountain of appointment, in the sides of the north. 14 I will rise over the heights of the clouds; I will be compared to Elyone (The Most High).* Here the key text is "I will be compared to Elyone (The Most High)." The great deception is with the word **compared**. Something that is compare to that which is real is close but it's not the real or authentic. In other words there will be something that will look like, act like, but some things will be missing. In this case what missing is Truth. HaSatan is the Father of lies. Passing himself off as the Son of the Creator.

Since there are no "j's" in the Hebrew Alef Bet and the Father named His Son before the foundation of the world, I side with our Messianic Fathers the Emissaries that He was known with the Yod as in "Y" and submit that they knew Him only as YeShua or Yehoshua.
